

## Be My Valentine

### Materials needed:

Available at [SonoranBeads.com](http://SonoranBeads.com):

- 1- Heart - #21252
- 1 - Grande Silk Cord #2744 Sunmist
- 3 - Siam AB - 6mm bicone crystal #3214
- 1 - Pendant Suspension -Copper #1990
- 2 - Glass End Caps #1514
- 1 - Toggle Clasp #1667

### From your stash:

- 2 - 3" piece 22g craft wire -gold color
- 2 - 6mm jump rings - gold color
- 1 - decorative head pin - 2 ½" long

### Tools needed:

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters



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#### Step-by-step instructions:

1. Insert the decorative head pin up through the heart, slide one 6mm crystal on the headpin and make a wire wrapped loop.
2. Slide the heart onto the pendant suspension and let it hang from the middle of the pendant suspension.
3. Cut the silk cord to the desired length for the necklace \* - keeping in mind the clasp will add at least a couple of inches.
4. Insert one of the 3" pieces of craft wire through the end of the silk cord - down about 1/8 inch from the end and wrap a small piece of the wire around itself. Snip off what is left of the small piece of wire. Insert the longer piece of wire up through the end cap, slide on a 6mm crystal and form a wire wrapped loop. Repeat with the other side.
5. Attach the clasp to the necklace using jump rings.
6. Position the Pendant Suspension in the center of the necklace. Start from the center of the pendant suspension, wrap first one side of the cord around the wire and then the other side.

#### \*Alternate Closure:

1 - Bamboo Magnetic Clasp #2953



Cut the cord to the desired length, use two part epoxy to glue the necklace ends into the magnetic clasp. Let dry 30 min - preferably overnight.
