

## Glass Tile and Pearl Necklace

Finished length approx. 20 inches

### Materials needed:

Available at [SonoranBeads.com](http://SonoranBeads.com):

- 7-Sonoran Boro Tiles #3266Black
- 1-Tube 4mm Purple Black Metallic Iris Cubes #1486
- Toggle Clasp #2828

### From your stash:

- Size 15° Capri/Dark Ruby seed beads
- Crimp Beads - Qty 2
- Crimp Covers - Qty 2
- Beading Wire - size .014 or .015
- 10-tile pearls
- 35-40 lg rice pearls

### Tools needed:

- Wire cutters
- Crimp tool



## Sonoran Beads

### Step-by-step instructions:

1. Cut a piece of size .014 or .015 beading wire to approximately 24 inches. Starting with a glass tile bead string on in the following order until all of the glass tiles are strung:  
1-glass tile bead, 1-4mm cube, 1-pearl tile, 1-4mm cube
2. When the last glass tile is strung add on one side:  
1-pearl tile, 1-4mm cube, 1-pearl tile, 1- 15° seed bead
3. Now add; a large rice pearl, a size 15° seed bead until you have added the quantity you want. Always finish with a seed bead. Repeat with the other side.
4. This is where you can add or subtract pearls and seed beads to reach the desired length of the necklace.
5. Finish by crimping on the clasp to both sides.

Note: The size 15° seed beads between the pearls adds a bit of color and gives a finished look. The color listed above is only a suggestion. There is a rainbow of colors in the dichro on the glass tiles. Any color can be picked up from the dichro and used to add that bit color between the rice pearls.
