

Crocheted Wirelace™ Necklace

Materials needed:

Available at Sonoranbeads.com:

- 1-10 yd spool of 1mm WireLace™
- 36- 4mm-6mm crystals
- 1-pair of clamshells-silvertone #1657
- 1-S-clasp- silver-#3455

Tools needed:

- 1-crochet hook- size F
- 2-Chain nose pliers

Step-by-step instructions:

1. String 12 crystals onto the WireLace™. DO NOT CUT THE STRAND.
2. Leaving a 6” tail, chain 30.
3. Slide a crystal down the strand to the last chain stitch and chain 1 around the crystal.
4. Chain 5 without crystals, chain 1 with a crystal. Repeat this step until you have used all the crystals on the WireLace™.
5. Chain 30 and end off. Cut the WireLace™ leaving a 6” tail.
6. Repeat steps 1 through 5 twice.
7. Gather one end of each of the crocheted strands together and tie a knot close to the end of the strands and trim.
8. Put the knot into a clamshell and close the clamshell with your pliers.
9. Open the ring on the clamshell and attach one end of your clasp.
10. Repeat steps 7 through 9 on the other end of the strands to complete the necklace.
