- 1pr Capture Double End Caps #2748
- 4-6 inches Golden Capture Chain #2503
- 1pr. Vermeil Earring Wires#696

Tools & Supplies needed:

- Nylon Pliers or coated pliers
- Beading Thread and Needle
- Wire cutters

Step-by-step instructions:

Starfish Earrings

1. Cut a length of capture chain 2 or 3 inches long depending on how long you want the earrings to dangle.
2. Stitch the Starfish in the center of the capture chain, weaving your needle through the openings in the chain passing the thread through the opening in the back of the starfish, cinch the thread and secure the stitching with a couple of knots.
3. Bring the two ends together and insert them into the end cap and crimp the end cap closed around the capture chain. Use nylon pliers or coated pliers so the surface of the end caps are not marred. Slide an earring wire onto the loop in the end cap. Repeat for the other earring.

Other Choices

1. Repeat step one above
2. Slide the capture chain through the opening in the bead.
3. Repeat step three above.
