

## Pearlesque Double Coin Knot Bracelet

### Materials needed:

Available at [SonoranBeads.com](http://SonoranBeads.com):

- 36" SilverSilk™ Shimmering Copper Pearlesque Capture Chain #2960
- 36" SilverSilk™ Golden Pearlesque Capture Chain #2960
- 2 - Barrel Slider Beads #3420
- 1 - Set Gold Plated SilverSilk™ Double Capture End Caps #2748
- 1 - Antique Gold Ball and Socket Clasp #3307
- 2 - 3.5mm jump rings #3418 Gold

### Tools Needed:

- Nylon Jaw or Coated Chain Nose Pliers
- Wire Cutters
- Macramé Board (optional)



## Sonoran Beads

### Step-by-step instructions:

1. String one Barrel Slider onto two strands of the SilverSilk™ Pearlesque Capture Chain. Insert the ends of the capture chain into one double end cap and close using the nylon jaw or coated chain nose pliers. Attaching the clasp to a Macramé board will allow you to have both hands free to create the knots - this is optional.
2. Position the Shimmering Copper on the **left** hand side and the Golden on the **right** hand side. Make a loop with the Shimmering Copper strand so that the tail is to the back. Position the Golden strand on top of the copper loop. [Fig.1](#)

3. Bring the golden tail under the copper tail; wrap over the copper strand between the two colors; wrap under the loop [Fig.2](#); wrap over the golden strand; under the copper loop and bring the tail out the other side. [Fig. 3](#) Cinch the knot to tighten it to the size that appeals to you. [Fig.4](#) Continue making knots until you reach the desired length. The beads and clasp will add about 2.5" to the overall length.
4. To finish; string the other Barrel Slider onto the two strands, insert the ends into the end cap and close. Add the clasp using the two jump rings.
