

## Simply Shibori – Lapis Sky

### Material list:

- Shibori Silk – 1yd #2725 Lapis Sky
- Flat End Caps – 20mm #3230
- Hook & Eye clasp #3227
- Cobalt Coin #21468
- Etched Bale #66

### From your stash:

- Head Pin - 1
- Jump rings - 2

### Tools needed:

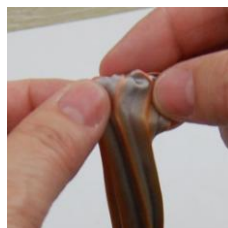
- Scissors
- Round nosed pliers
- Wire cutters
- Nylon Flat Pliers
- Needle & Thread (or sewing Machine)



## Sonoran Beads

### Step-by-step instructions:

- Make a tube out of the silk by folding the silk in half – length wise, right sides together. Stitch the sides either by hand or on a sewing machine. Turn right side out.
- Sew a seam at both ends of the tube to keep the silk from fraying. Trim the edges and snip any loose threads close to the silk.
- Clasp one end of the silk between your fingers. Placing the seam perpendicular to your fingers pull the silk out slightly. Tuck the seam over and grasp it with your fingers. This will hide the seam in the end cap giving you a nice finished end.



- Place the finished silk end into the flat end cap and press closed. Protect the end cap by using nylon pliers or cover the end cap with cloth or a tissue to keep from marring the surface.
- Attach the clasp with jump rings. Wire-wrap the Coin pendant with a sterling silver head pin – you may have to use a seed bead or crystal to help keep the head pin in place. Attach the wire loop to the split ring in the etched bale – close the split ring. Position the bale in the center of the necklace and close.
