

Hooked on Leather Bracelet

Materials needed:

Available at SonoranBeads.com:

- 24" SilverSilk Leather - Silver wire over black leather #3627
- 1 - Antique Silver Hook Clasp #3736
- 3 - Pkgs Leather Components #3738

Tools Needed:

- Chain nosed pliers
- Wire cutters
- Jewelry glue or Two part epoxy



Sonoran Beads

Step-by-step instructions:

1. Cut two pieces of SilverSilk™ Leather 12" long.
2. Fold one piece in half forming a loop large enough to fit over the hook end of the clasp. Join with a leather component by slipping it around both strands of leather at the base of the loop and gently crimping it.
3. Fold the second piece of leather around the first one, you will now have four strands of leather to work with. Use a leather component to join each pair of leather strands just below the first leather component used.
4. Keeping the leather flat and even, join the two center strand together with a leather component about 2" away from the first set of components.
5. Join the outer strands to the center strands as you did in step 3.
6. Trim the loose ends of the leather so that they are even, fill the cavity end of the clasp with glue and insert the leather ends. Set aside to dry.
