

Pearlesque Capture Pendant

Materials needed:

Available at SonoranBeads.com:

- 36" SilverSilk™ Golden Pearlesque Capture Chain #2960
- 1 – extra large pendant tray #3690
- 1 – Button #3299 Rose
- 1 – Set Gold Plated SilverSilk™ Single Capture End Caps #2477
- 1 – Toggle Clasp #FT3
- 2 – 3.5mm jump rings #3344 Gold

From your Stash:

- Gel Control Super Glue
- Glue Dots

Tools Needed:

- 2 - Chain Nose Pliers (for jump rings)
- Wire Cutters
- Coated Chain Nose Pliers or Nylon Jaw Pliers (for end caps)

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Step-by-step instructions:

1. Position 3 – 4 glue dots around the pendant tray. These will help hold the capture chain in place as you coil it inside the tray. Burnish the colored dots with your finger to firmly affix it to the tray. **(Fig.1)** Peel the colored coating off the dots.

2. Cut a piece of Pearlesque Capture Chain approximately 16" long. Pull the bead chain out of one end and cut two beads off. Tuck the rest of the bead chain back into the capture. With your chain nose pliers, gently flatten the end bead on the bead chain you just tucked back in. Starting at the side coil the capture around the edge of the tray. Keep coiling around until you have a space about 10mm wide in the middle. **(Fig.2)** Cut off any excess chain, if any. At this point you can reposition the chain to make sure it is positioned to your liking.
3. Fill the center space with Gel Glue and insert the button. Let dry for 30 min. before finishing the necklace.
4. Cut the remaining Pearlesque Capture Chain to the desired length and string on the pendant. Insert each end of the capture into an end cap and close it with your coated or nylon jaw pliers. Attach the clasp using the two jump rings and your chain nose pliers.

This is a perfect pallet for embellishing. Use your stash to create endless designs. They make great gifts! Enjoy!
