



String of Galaxy Pearls



Finished Length: 19"

Supply List –available at SonoranBeads.com

- 1 – 2' pkg. Galaxy – “Polaris” - #3757
- 1 –pkg. (50pc) 8mm Glass Pearls - #3765
- 1 – Acrylic Oval Magnetic clasp – Pearl – #3725

From your stash:

Glue – Two part epoxy or E6000 – (do not use super glue)

Tools Needed:

- 3/16" Wooden Dowel
- Flush Wire Cutters
- Flat nosed pliers

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Instructions:

1. Starting ½" from the end twist one end of the Galaxy knitted wire tube closed. Twist around a couple of times for a tight closure.



2. Drop an 8mm pearl into the tube and gently tamp it down to the end of the tube with the wooden dowel. Remove the dowel and with the flat nosed pliers grip the tube right above the pearl and twist. Continue dropping and twisting the pearls until you have reached the end leaving about a ½ inch tail.



3. Twist the ends completely forming a cylinder and then flatten with the flat nosed pliers. Measure the depth of the glue-in end cap/clasp by inserting the tube ends into the clasp. Trim to fit before gluing the ends into the clasp. Follow the manufactures directions for gluing.



This also makes a great bracelet! Fill the tube with pearls (or crystals!) until you reach the desired length – don't forget to include the length of the clasp.
